Traditional Japanese homes are made of wood and supported by wooden pillars, but today houses are often supported with steel pillars.

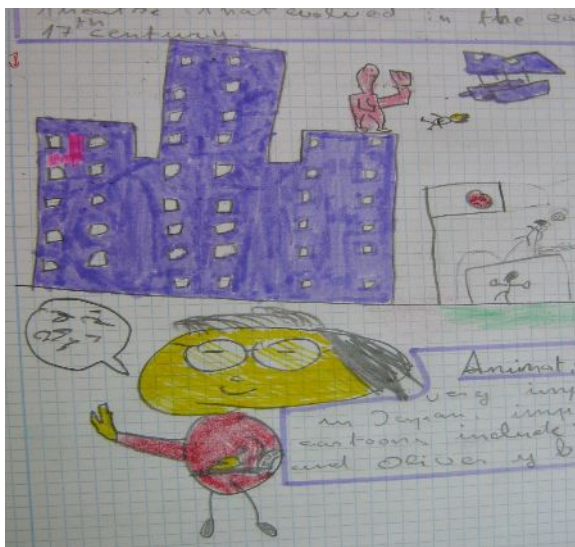
Shoes are never worn in the houses.
